The clubhouse will only be used to sign up for your rounds with an "enter only" and "exit only" door. Social distancing is required. Therefore, you cannot keep your guns or shooting bags in the clubhouse. You can use the gun racks and tables outside.

MSC Re-Opening Guidelines Wednesday, June 17th

We have been anxiously awaiting the re-opening of McHenry Sportsmen's Club following the Governor's mandate and our "annual" spring flooding of the trap fields. We are under strict guidelines from the State of Illinois and the CDC at this time for our re-opening.

In the case of inclement weather, we remind everyone to call the clubhouse at (815)385-9896 before heading out to confirm the open status of the club as the clubhouse cannot be used as shelter. If you are already at the club and it begins to rain, you'll have to shelter in your car.

WE CANNOT STRESS ENOUGH IF YOU OR A FAMILY MEMBER ARE FEELING ILL, PLEASE STAY HOME

To ensure everyone's safety and enjoyment, it is up to the members to police themselves and participants that these rules and guidelines are followed. This will help keep the club from initiating stricter rules and keep the club open. Volunteers are always needed.

In accordance with the CDC guidelines, social distancing of at least 6 feet, no more than ten people in a group and a minimum of 30 feet between groups. Facial masks are required. The McHenry Sportsmen's Club will not supply these items or sanitizing wipes. Remember, we do not have running water so please bring your own sanitizer.

The clubhouse will be used for signing up purposes only with a one-way traffic pattern. Face masks must be worn inside the clubhouse. The door closest to the parking lot will be "enter only" and the door exiting onto the deck will be "exit only". Areas will be marked off for social distancing inside the clubhouse. You must keep your guns and shooting bags outside with you. No congregating inside the clubhouse will be allowed.

No coaching or instruction will be permitted during this time.

No food or coffee will be offered. You may purchase soda from the machines or water from the front counter.

Once you sign up, we ask that you be ready to shoot so when your squad is called so we can keep the progression going to allow everyone an equal opportunity to shoot.

If moving the voice callers, we advise that you wear gloves to prevent the spread of germs.

Trap staff obligations will only be to open, load and close the trap houses only. For your safety and theirs, please do not engage with them. You must pick up your hulls.

Please limit your movement on the grounds and be aware of social distancing and be courteous of others.

We encourage you to being the proper amount of shells with you on the shooting line to minimize activity.

In addition to these requirements, please follow all gun safety and rules that are currently in place at the club.
